It is regrettable that we send this letter of notification to inform you that our 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Picnic has been **postponed** to a date yet to be determined.


There have unfortunately been on-going circumstances with the Queen Mary facility regarding the 21 July 2018 date, We were recently informed by the Queen Mary that the City of Long Beach cannot approve our picnic permit as it interferes with another very large event taking place within the city on the same date. As a result, the City of Long Beach is unable to dedicate the first responder resources required (Police/Fire) for the successful and safe execution of our local wide picnic. This **postponement** is solely due to the Queen Mary's failure to coordinate with the City of Long Beach and internally with its contractually bound dates (original June 16, 2018 and July 21, 2018) with IBEW Local 11.


Given the inconvenience the Queen Mary has now thrust upon us for a second time and their ongoing personnel changes, we are not confident moving forward with this facility.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this has caused you. Please know that all Picnic Tickets purchased on line for the 2018 Annual Picnic will be reimbursed and credited back to your account in the upcoming weeks. Those ticket holders that have purchased their tickets from a Staff Member (Business Agent/Organizer) will also be reimbursed in their entirety upon turning in your tickets to that Staff Member of whom you purchased from. All journey level and apprentices who've purchased their picnic tickets at ETI can surrender their tickets there with Eric Brown for a refund during normal business hours. Cut-off date for refunds will be 31 Aug 2018. We kindly ask for your patience during this process.

Attached on the reverse side is a copy of the Queen Mary's Cancellation Letter to us for your situational awareness. Once we establish a new venue and date we will inform you all. Again, this letter serves as notice that our 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Picnic on 21 July 2018 has been **postponed** until further notice.

Dear Ms. Martinez,

With deepest regrets, I am writing to notify you that The Queen Mary/Urban Commons Queensway LLC has been forced to cancel your event dated July 21, 2018 pursuant to Paragraph 37 in our agreement. In accordance with those terms, without a permit this event simply cannot proceed, and as you know City of Long Beach public safety has not issued the necessary approvals.

In keeping with our agreement we will be processing an immediate refund of your deposit(s).

In light of this unforeseen development, we are happy to offer an alternate date of August 25, 2018. The City of Long Beach has already issued approvals for your event on that date.

Additionally, as this matter was well beyond the control of your organization please know that we will not pursue any of the remedies available to us outlined under Paragraph 37.
