Sisters and brothers,

Please review the letter sent to IBEW 11 members regarding the upcoming contract ratification meeting. As CE/CW members working under the IBEW, 9th District Market Advancement Memorandum of Understanding, you are subject to the terms and conditions of the Inside Wireman's Agreement. Consequently, you have the right to vote on this new agreement. It you plan to attend; you must bring an official printed yellow dues receipt paid through July 2019. If the new contract is not ratified by the members in attendance, we will go on strike.

IBEW 11 has assigned a business agent to represent you and ensure your continued success and advancement through the CE/CW program. Jaime Sanchez can be reached at 323-552-8833 or Ivan DeHerrera at 626-660-9479. Call them if you have any questions or concerns. They will also help you receive upgrades, schedule classes and make sure you progress through this important arm of the IBEW. The goal is to become an Inside Wireman and continue to support your Local Union.

Below are some notes to keep you on track:

The State of California requires 150 hours of continuing education per year to maintain the Electrical Trainee Certification. Two semesters of CW classes per year will meet this requirement.

Approved classes in conjunction with work hours are the only way for a CE/CW to receive upgrades.

CW Electrician Trainees will be required to pay a \$25-dollar deposit fee per class to register. CE Electricians will be required to pay a \$90-dollar deposit fee per class to register.

TO REGISTER YOU MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Properly completed CE/CW class registration form(s)
- Separate deposit payments for each class selected (check, money order or credit card-Visa or Mastercard only- All checks will be deposited immediately).
- Current IBEW 11 dues receipt

ALL DEPOSITS WILL BE REFUNDED UPON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE CLASS

You must achieve a minimum grade of 70% in order to pass each class. Failure to complete the course with a minimum passing grade, no shows or missing more than 20% of the class will result in forfeiture of your deposit.
